DfT & DVLA review of registration processes

- Your chance to share your thoughts -

The DfT and the DVLA are seeking expertise and knowledge about whether the policies around the registration processes for historic, classic and rebuilt vehicles need updating to reflect evolving technologies that support the restoration and rebuilding of these vehicles. An example of evolving technologies include conversion to electric power.

They are keen to tap into a range of experience, views and research to help identify areas of potential change, whilst ensuring that road safety and accurate vehicle records on the national register remain a key priority.

The call for evidence asks for evidence on a number of topics including:

- historic/classic vehicles registration
- rebuilt and restored vehicles
- kit-built vehicles
- vehicles converted to electric propulsion
- Q registration numbers
- the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
