MODIFICATION: Introduction of cup plugs to replace core plugs.

Engine serial numbers:

Series III 21/4 petrol, 8:1 compression ratio, from 90128693A onwards. Series III $2\frac{1}{4}$ petrol, 7:1 compression ratio, from 90409601A onwards. Series III $2\frac{1}{4}$ diesel, from 90613322A onwards. Series III $2\frac{1}{4}$ petrol, U.S.A. hard top, from 25601304A onwards.

REMARKS:

Cup plugs are now fitted in place of the threaded core plugs from the above engine serial numbers onwards.

Both plugs will be stocked by our Parts Department at Cardiff as they are not interchangeable.




Fig. 1 Identification of cylinder block plugs A—Core plug

SUBJECT: EXHAUST MANIFOLD CRACKING

MODELS: Land-Rover Series III 24 litre petrol.

B-Cup plug

MODIFICATION: Introduction of anti-seize compound to reduce tendency for the exhaust manifold to

crack.

PART NUMBER:

Anti-seize compound (Rocol Limited) Foliac J 166 (paste)

COMMENCING NUMBERS:

Engine serial numbers:

Series III $2\frac{1}{4}$ litre petrol, 8:1 c. ratio, from 90129286A onwards. Series III $2\frac{1}{4}$ litre petrol, 7:1 c. ratio, from 90409678A onwards. Series III $2\frac{1}{4}$ litre petrol, U.S.A. hard top, from 25601327A onwards.

REMARKS:

To reduce the tendency for exhaust manifolds to fracture in service, the cylinder head engaging surfaces of the manifold should be moderately coated with 'Foliac' anti-seize compound. Care must be taken to ensure that the manifold faces are clean and flat and the coating of the compound is applied just prior to fitting the assembly to the cylinder head. The manifold fixings should then be tightened to 1,3 kgfm (10 lbf ft).

This anti-seize compound is not stocked by Rover British Leyland UK Ltd. and should be obtained from local motor factors. In the event of supply difficulties apply direct to the manufacturers:




Fig. 2 Application of Foliac anti-seize compound to exhaust manifold A—Apply compound moderately to these areas

SUBJECT: GEAR

GEAR LEVER BALL END

MODELS:

Land-Rover Series III.

MODIFICATION:

Introduction of finalised details in respect of gear lever ball end originally introduced

in Service Information Vol. 1, No. 7, item 23.

PART NUMBERS: Gear change lever with ball end only:

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COMMENCING NUMBERS:

Gearbox serial numbers:

Land-Rover 2½ litre, from 90134983A onwards. Land-Rover 2.6 litre, from 94103134A onwards.

REMARKS:

A few isolated failures have occurred since the introduction of the revised material specification. These failures were experienced in one batch only which was subsequently found to be to an incorrect material specification.

This situation has now been rectified and all supplies from the above gearbox serial

numbers are to the correct specifications.

Any failures of gear lever ball ends on gearboxes after the above numbers should be reported immediately to the Technical Service Department, using the appropriate Product Defect Report Form: UK Part No. AKD 8002, Export Part No. AKD 5181.




Fig. 3 Gear lever ball end A—Gear change lever B—Ball end

SUBJECT: REAR CROSS MEMBER

MODELS: Land-Rover Series IIA and III.

MODIFICATION: Introduction of rear cross member as a separate item to avoid the need of a complete chassis frame to be fitted where the damage is restricted to the rear cross member.

REMARKS:

Owing to its location and the subsequent danger of exposure to corrosion and susceptibility to rear collision damage the rear cross member on the chassis frame is now available from our Parts Department at Cardiff as a separate item under the above part number.

Although the replacement of the rear chassis cross member can be effected without the use of a jig, the rear body must be removed as detailed in the appropriate Workshop or Repair Operation Manual.




Fig. 4 Rear cross member location
