AXLE DIFFERENTIAL, WARRANTY CLAIMS

REMARKS:

When submitting a Warranty Claim for differential units, Overseas Distributors must quote the identification number of the unit concerned. This number will be found stamped on the top periphery of the differential casing in one of the three following ranges.

- Note 1 With effect from this date Warranty Claims for differential units will not be cleared for payment unless the above information is given.
- Note 2 Do not confuse the differential unit number with the axle serial number which is stamped on the underside of the axle casing.

Item 250 SUBJECT:

CLEANING RADIATOR

MODELS:

All Land-Rovers.

REMARKS:

Under certain operating conditions the radiator fins tend to become obstructed over a period of time, due to the accumulation of dirt, straw, insects etc.

It is necessary, therefore, occasionally to remove this foreign matter, to ensure that the radiator efficiency is not impaired.

Apply compressed air or water pressure from the rear, so forcing the foreign matter out through the front of the radiator. Never use a metal implement for this purpose, or serious damage may result to the radiator core.
