	REMARKS:	It should be noted that all future service supplies of trailer lighting equipment will be of the seven-pin type. It is, of course, a legal requirement in the United Kingdom to fit an appropriate type of plug and socket to ensure that the flashers in the direction of turn, at the front of the vehicle, the rear of the vehicle and on the trailer flash simultaneously.
