SUBJECT: SERVICE LITERATURE (POLICY ITEM).

MODELS: All Land-Rovers

REMARKS: To ensure maximum dissemination of the information given in our circular letter dated 16th September, 1971, reference AVH/JMP, we are repeating below the details in respect of Land-Rovers.

Repair Operation Manuals are becoming increasingly expensive to produce, and to offset this expense and to ensure that they are treated as items of value, a special nominal charge of £1.50 will be made for the initial issues of new Workshop Manuals/Repair Operation Manuals on and after the 1 Oct 1971.

The above price will apply to all manuals - English and translated versions - which are issued whenever a new model is introduced. No charge will be made for subsequent amendments to these publications.

Two copies only will be issued to each Distributor and one copy only to each Dealer and Fleet Owner at this special price. All additional copies must be ordered from the Parts Department, Cardiff, and paid for at the normal rate, as detailed below, less discount where applicable.

In making these changes to our previous practice, the Rover Company is conforming with policy established throughout the British Leyland car companies.

With effect from the 1 Oct 1971 a nominal charge will be made for the initial kit of Service literature provided to new Distributors and Dealers on their appointments. In the case of new Dealer appointments, a set of literature will be posted and invoiced to the Distributor concerned, who will be asked to forward on to the Dealer.

Part numbers have been allocated for the Service literature kits and these, with the nominal charges which will apply, are given below.

SUBJECT: P.C.M.I. TRANSPARENCY READER LAMP

REMARKS: We have been informed by NCR Ltd., that owing to continually rising costs in the manufacture of their P.C.M.I. transparency reader lamps, they have no alternative but to increase the price by 20p from £2.00 to £2.20 each as from 1st January, 1972 onwards. The lamps should continue to be ordered direct from the usual NCR outlets.
